Substitute teachers will take attendance, supervise, and ensure that students are following the direction or plans left by the absent teacher. Substitute teachers will collect work, and leave it for the absent teacher. The substitute teacher would also leave any notes, questions, or concerns requiring attention for the absent teacher, upon their return. Substitute teachers will be paid at the rate of \$100.00 per day
